Course Overview



> Skills Development:

The Level 2 Diploma allows you to develop and demonstrate competence in health and social care, while also building technical skills, knowledge, and understanding relevant to specific job roles.



> Online Learning:

This diploma is primarily online. Upon enrolment, you'll gain access to your portal where you can view modules and assignments. Our dedicated tutors are available to support you via phone, email, or video whenever needed.

> Duration:

The course typically takes around 9 months, though this may vary depending on your personal time commitments.



> Workplace Observations:

The program includes two workplace observations, the first will take place remotely, via video and the second observation will take place in your workplace.



> Eligibility Criteria:

To enrol in this diploma, you should be actively involved in:

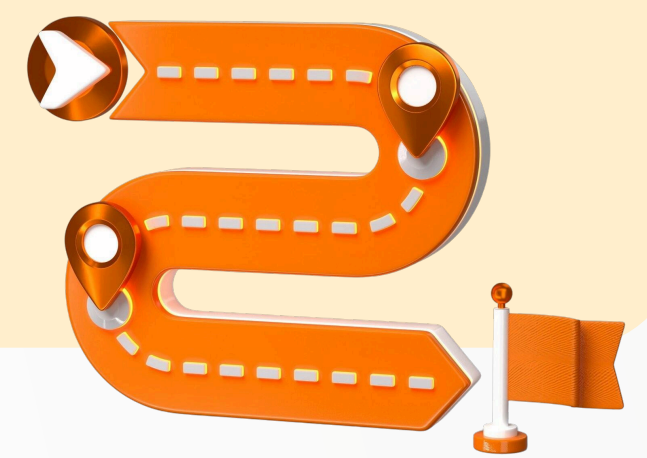
- Regular supervisions
